1 72 HOLE STROKEPLAY (PRIZE MONEY R3 000 000):
Prize money will be paid out to all professionals making the cut in the 72 hole strokeplay competition according to the breakdown published in the 2012 Sunshine Tour General Regulations.

72 HOLE BETTERBALL MEDAL (PRIZE MONEY R200 000):
156 Professionals and 156 Amateurs make up the Pro-Am field.
The professionals in the leading 25 Betterball Medal teams, contesting the final round, will be paid prize money as per the breakdown published on the tournament notice board.

2 CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION

Conditions of Competition (72 hole Strokeplay)

The competition will be decided over 72 holes Strokeplay. All contestants participate upto the third round. Each contestant will play one round on Montagu, Outeniqua & The Links Golf Courses. On conclusion of the third round there will be a cut to 65th placed professional and those tying. All contestants making the 54 hole cut participate in the final round at Montagu GC. In the event of a tie for first place, there will be a sudden death playoff on holes to be determined by the Tournament Director.

Conditions of Competition (Betterball Medal)

Each Betterball team in this competition is made up of one professional and one amateur. Players drawn together in one team stay together for the duration of the tournament. The format is Betterball Medal, the best net score on each hole to count. Each team will play one round on the Montagu, Outeniqua & The Links Golf Courses. On conclusion of the third round there will be a cut to the leading 25 team scores. All teams making the 54 hole cut will contest the final round to be played on the Montagu GC. **ALL PROFESSIONALS IN A TEAM MAKING THE CUT ARE REQUIRED TO CONTEST THE FOURTH ROUND WHETHER OR NOT THEY MAKE THE PRO CUT.** All professionals contesting the final round of the Betterball Medal will receive prize money.

If more than one team records the same cut score (Round 3) then there will be a count out as follows using scores recorded on the Montagu Golf Course only:

- Lowest 18 hole score;
- If there is still a tie then the lowest score over holes 10 to 18;
- If there is still a tie then the lowest score over holes 13 to 18;
- If there is still a tie then the lowest score over holes 16 to 18;
- If there is still a tie then the lowest score on hole 18;
- If there is still a tie, the teams making the cut will be determined in a manner decided by the Sunshine Tour.

In the event of more than one team tying on the winning score, on conclusion of the event, a count out will follow as outlined above using scores recorded during the fourth round.

Both competitions will be played according to the latest Rules published by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St.Andrews, Scotland, the 2012 Sunshine Tour Permanent Local Rules and Tournament Local rules as distributed on the Tees.
