## SCHOOLS INVITATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ANNUAL SANLAM KAY MOTSEPE CUP

The Sanlam Kay Motsepe Schools Cup is an annual memorial national tournament hosting over 5,000 schools from all nine provinces throughout South Africa competing at regional, provincial and national levels. The primary objective of the tournament is to revive the culture of school football amongst the students and the youth. Over the past five years the tournament has had a steady build-up and high schools enrolling for participation. The winning school in 2011 will take home R1million worth of improvements and facilities, with the remainder shared amongst the runner up schools up to fourth position. (Positions 2:R600K, 3:R500K and 4:R400K).

Co-funded by SANLAM, the Ubuntu-Botho Community Development Trust and the Motsepe Family Foundation, the Sanlam Kay Motsepe Schools Cup will receive R30 million (over a period of five years) – making it the biggest high schools soccer sponsorship with the largest prize money in the history of South African schools soccer. **The registration for the tournament will be from January 2011 to End February kick off will be from 9th March** and schools will participate on a knockout basis leading to the Provincial and National finals in July 2011.

The 2011 activation strategy is aimed at expanding the network of the tournament throughout all schools in South Africa and ensuring that there is participation in all the high schools in the country.
